INDICATIONS

Umbilical Tape is indicated for use in tying off the umbilical cord of newborn infants.

ACTIONS/PERFORMANCE None known.

CONTRAINDICATIONS Not intended for implantation.

WARNINGS

Do not resterilize. Do not re-process. Unit package is sterile unless it has been opened or damaged. Do not use if product packaging is wet. Discard open, unused tape.

In case device is re-used, it is impossible to guarantee its mechanical properties for intended use and there is a risk of cross-infection.

Store at room temperature. Avoid prolonged exposure to elevated temperatures.

Risk of biological contamination; please follow regional or national regulation for elimination of potential contaminated devices, for used tape disposal.

PRECAUTIONS

In handling this product, care should be taken to avoid damage. Avoid crushing or crimping damage due to application of surgical instruments such as forceps or needle holders.

HOW SUPPLIED

Umbilical tape single use cotton strips are available in sterile, white strands. The tape is supplied sterile in 1/8 inch wide by 18 inches, 30 inches, and 36 inches length in box quantities of 12 and 40 envelopes, and non sterile in 1/8 inch wide by 100 yards.

STERILITY


